**“A BLUE RIBBON AFFAIR ARTS, CRAFTS &

Admission is \$1. Children 12 and under are admitted free. Take Interstate-75 North to Exit 260 (Windy Hill Road) and go west. Go five miles and turn left on Austell Road.
