GENERAL RULES

1. The North Georgia State Fair will open its gates to the public at 4 p.m. Thursday, September 20. **The gates will be opened for the receipt of non-perishable exhibits on Saturday, September 15 from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday, September 16 from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. Baked Goods will be received on Wednesday, September 19 from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. and Agriculture/Horticulture Exhibits will be received on Wednesday, September 19 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.**
2. All non-perishable exhibits must be on the grounds and in place by 6 p.m. Sunday, September 16 (See Schedule). Exhibits must remain in place until check out time 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 30. (No Exceptions)
3. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE THE WORK OF AMATEUR EXHIBITORS. ARTICLES BOUGHT OR BORROWED WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEAN AND MUST HAVE BEEN MADE BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 30, 2006 AND THE DATE ENTERED. ENTRY LISTS ARE KEPT FROM PREVIOUS YEARS TO PREVENT THIS RULES INFRACTION. DISREGARD OF THESE STIPULATIONS WILL RESULT IN ARTICLES BEING DISQUALIFIED AND ANY ARTICLES DISQUALIFIED WILL NOT BE DISPLAYED.
4. Before an exhibit will be placed on display, it must be securely labeled with the proper entry tag; provided at Check In Desk.
5. Entry forms will be in triplicate and entry procedures will be clearly explained on entry forms available at the time exhibits are entered.
6. Exhibitors in all departments may enter ONLY ONE (1) ENTRY IN ANY ONE CLASS FOR EACH SHOW, and may receive only one (1) ribbon in any one class.
7. Awards will be designated by ribbons according to the records in the judge's book.
8. Judges will be authorized to withhold any ribbon, if in their opinion the exhibit is unworthy. THEIR DECISION IS FINAL.
9. Any exhibitor found using un-sportsman like means or acts or giving false information to persons receiving entries on behalf of the fair, shall be disqualified and barred from further participation, and all previous premiums shall be forfeited.
10. NO PERSONS OTHER THAN JUDGES, CLERKS, AND EXHIBIT STAGERS SHALL BE PERMITTED IN THE EXHIBIT HALL DURING JUDGING.
11. The Manager of the Fair, or an authorized official, shall have supervision and control of all exhibits and exhibitors for the fair, whether in the buildings or on the grounds and reserves the right to prescribe dimensions and regulate the position of all signs, to control the distribution of advertising matter and generally to direct the arrangement of articles and exhibitions so far as same may be necessary to maintain harmony.
12. WHILE EVERY REASONABLE PRECAUTION WILL BE TAKEN FOR SAFEGUARDING THE EXHIBITS, IT MUST BE UNDERSTOOD THAT THE EXHIBITS ARE IN COMPETITION FOR PRIZES, AND THE OWNERS ASSUME

ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY ACCIDENT, LOSS OR DAMAGE THAT MAY OCCUR. NEITHER THE FAIR ASSOCIATION, ITS OFFICERS, NOR VOLUNTEERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY SUCH ACCIDENTS, LOSS OR DAMAGE.

13. Passes will be issued to exhibitors and special guests at the discretion of the management. Each individual exhibitor will be entitled to one single pass for each class entered, not to exceed two (2) passes for any one individual on any entry date. Passes are to be picked up from a central distribution point after completion of entries.

14. No new classes will be added for one or two entries. At least three (3) entries must be presented by three (3) individuals for inclusion in judging and display.

15. The North Georgia State Fair Management reserves to itself the sole and absolute right to construe its own rules and regulations and to determine arbitrarily all matters and differences in regard thereto from which no appeal lies.

16. Please make sure that no names are showing on any article at the time of entry.

GENERAL RULES

Food Preservation, Foods, Handicrafts, Sewing

1. Prizes will be awarded on the basis of skill and quality of workmanship of article exhibited.

2. Committees will determine category for all items.

3. NO PERSON CAN ENTER MORE THAN ONE (1) ITEM IN ONE CLASS NUMBER.

4. Each canned product must have a canning label on it. Entrant's name should not show.

5. All items (except food) will only be accepted at the fairgrounds on Saturday, September 15 between 1 p.m. and 6 p.m. and on Sunday, September 16 between 1 p.m. and 6 p.m. only.

6. Baked goods will be accepted on Wednesday, September 19 between 2 p.m. and 8 p.m.

7. Jars must be standard canning jars, clear glass, and uniform in size. Make sure jars are sealed and rings (screw bands) are left on. No mayonnaise or other commercial jars will be accepted.

JUDGING CRITERION

CANNING

1. Appearance

A. Color 20

As nearly as possible the color of the freshly cooked product. Not faded or darkened to a great degree.

B. Clearness 20

Syrup or liquid clear and as free from sediment bubbles as possible. (Jelly usually translucent.)

B. Pack 20

Attractive - not a fancy pack. Uniformity of size and shape. Space should be full but the jar not crowded. (The liquid should cover the product but there should not be an excessive proportion of liquid to product.)

2. Texture 30

Tender, sound and uniform ripeness. Firm enough to hold shape. Vegetables not over mature. (Sweets - fruit tender, but firm, and plump and syrup thick.) Jelly tender, holds its shape.

2. Container 10

Standard canning jar only, with rings, no rust and no wax seal Labeled for contents at home. **PLEASE NO NAMES ON JARS!**
