ABOUT THE EVENT

The Kids Power Wheels Derby is a lighthearted, action-packed event where children drive their own Power Wheels vehicles while trying to protect the balloons taped to their car. Each vehicle will be fitted with four balloons, one on each side. The objective? Be the last vehicle with an unpopped balloon!

AGE GROUPS

- Ages 3–5
- Ages 6–8

VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a “ride-in” Power Wheels-style vehicle (no straddle or ATV-style vehicles)
- Motors must remain stock – no performance modifications allowed
- Vehicles must run on 6V or 12V only
- Tires must be stock (may be reinforced with duct tape)
- All doors and tailgates must be secured shut with zip ties, duct tape, or similar flexible materials
- No sharp edges or added structures
- Only one driver per vehicle – no passengers

WAIVER, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

2026 North Georgia State Fair – Kids Power Wheels Derby

My child is planning to participate in the Kids Power Wheels Derby at the 2026 North Georgia State Fair. I request that my child be permitted to participate in this event.

- I understand and agree to the following:
- I will be physically present at the event and will personally supervise my child before, during, and after their participation in the Kids Power Wheels Derby.
- I understand that if I am not present, my child will not be allowed to participate.
- I understand that participation in activities involving motorized ride-on vehicles such as Power Wheels involves inherent risks, including but not limited to collisions, tipping, falls, or equipment malfunctions, which could result in serious injury to my child or myself.
- I acknowledge that while safety precautions are taken, accidents can occur, and participation is voluntary.

Being fully aware of the risks involved, for myself and on behalf of my child, **I voluntarily assume all risks associated with this activity. I hereby fully and forever release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue the following entities and individuals**, collectively referred to as “the Releases”:

The Cobb County Fair Association, Cobb County Government, and all of their respective subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, members, agents, volunteers, participants, sponsors, representatives, sanctioned entities, advertisers, and any other individuals or organizations involved in the planning, execution, or operation of the Kids Power Wheels Derby.

I further agree to hold harmless and indemnify the Releases from any and all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages to my child, to myself, to my spouse, or to our personal representatives, heirs, assigns, or next of kin. This includes, but is not limited to, claims for personal injury, disability, death, or property damage, whether caused by the negligence of the Releases or otherwise, while participating in, observing, or being in the vicinity of the Kids Power Wheels Derby.

For purposes of this waiver, the term “Restricted Area” includes, but is not limited to: the competition arena, vehicle staging area, entryways, walkways, spectator areas, and any other locations associated with the operation of this event.

Rules

Vehicle Requirements

- Any regular electric Power Wheels vehicle is allowed
- No 4-wheeler or ATV-style vehicles permitted
- Vehicle must be a ride-in design — child's legs must be inside the body of the vehicle
- Motors must remain stock – no performance modifications
- Only 6V or 12V batteries allowed
- Batteries may be changed out but must not exceed a 12V lawn and seed battery
- Stock tires only – tires may be covered with duct tape to prevent cracking
- No sharp edges or hard additions; all doors and tailgates must be strapped shut using zip ties, duct tape, or similar soft material
- No passengers – only one child per vehicle

Game Format

- Before the start of the derby, a supervisor will tape one balloon to each side of every vehicle
- Kids will drive around the arena attempting to pop other participants' balloons while protecting their own
- The event will be conducted in a safe, controlled space with supervisors monitoring
- Aggressive behavior is not allowed
- The last vehicle with at least one balloon unpopped will be declared the winner of their age group

Participant Requirements

- Children must be between the ages of 3 and 8 years old
- Divided into two age groups: 3–5 years and 6–8 years
- A parent or legal guardian must sign the official registration and waiver form
- All drivers must check in at least 30 minutes before event start time

Safety Guidelines

- Helmets are required – may be brought from home or provided at check-in
- Seatbelts are recommended
- Closed-toe shoes must be worn (no flip-flops or sandals)
- Long pants and long sleeves recommended for added protection

Registration

- Event will take place during the intermission of the Demolition Derby. Please report to the Ez-up tent that says, “Kids power wheel derby Registration” to be checked in.
