Dear Fair Family, Friends, and Fans,

As we prepare for the 2022 Superior Plumbing Presents North Georgia State Fair, we would like to make you aware of some capital improvements and policy changes. We are making these changes with your safety and the best interest of the fair in mind. The Cobb County Fair Association recently invested \$130,000 in new LED lights for the carnival midway and a \$200,000 camera/security system for Jim R. Miller Park. These capital improvements will be completed before this year's fair.

Along with these capital improvements, we have instituted some policy changes. These policy changes are to ensure every fair goer's safety and to maintain the integrity of our event.

Youth Attendance Policy: After 6pm each day, no individual under the age of 17 will be allowed admission without a parent.

Clear Bag Policy: Only clear bags will be allowed and must not exceed 12" x 6" x 12". One-gallon clear plastic freezer bags and small clutch purses, no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" are also permitted. Diaper bags are allowed but subject to search.

Gate Entry Policy: No fair entry allowed Sunday through Thursday after 9:00pm, and Friday and Saturday after 10:00pm

All the above additions and policies are with your safety in mind and after much consulting with state and national fair representatives. These policies are in line with multiple sports and entertainment venues across the country.

We hope you will join us for FALL NIGHTS AND CARNIVAL LIGHTS September 22-October 2, 2022, at Jim R. Miller Park in Marietta.
