Background: As the largest fair in metro Atlanta, the Superior Plumbing Presents North Georgia State Fair attracts over 365,000 people every year from north Georgia and neighboring states. The Fair features not one, but two petting barns featuring barnyard and exotic animals, flower shows; blue ribbon competitions for handmade goods and items, fruits, vegetables and artwork of all kinds; local entertainment, and delicious fair foods including all of the traditional fare, as well as lots of unexpected culinary delights. The price of admission also covers numerous world class ground acts, including the brand new Carriage Kia Grand Stand Series featuring the Piccolo Zoppe Boutique circus, Demolition Derby, Full Throttle Monster Trucks, and the American Bull Riders Tour. The family owned and operated Great James H. Drew Exposition Midway, one of the largest carnival midways in the United States, features a wide assortment of carnival games, entertainment, and exciting rides for thrill-seekers of all ages, including the Wildcat Rollercoaster, the Georgia Mountain Lift and the Mega Slide.

Free Carriage Kia Grandstand Events: The covered arena will feature a variety of amazing, family-friendly events including the Piccolo Zoppe Boutique Circus September 21-24, Demolition Derby September 25 & 28, Full Throttle Monster Trucks September 26-27, and The American Bull Riders Tour September 29-October 1st. All Carriage Kia Grandstand events are FREE with fair admission.

North Georgia Animals Petting Barn:

Clear Bag Policy: Clear Bags may not exceed 12"x6"x12". One-gallon resealable clear plastic freezer bags and small clutch purses no larger than 4.5"x 6.5" are also permitted.

Gate Entry Policy: No Fair Entry Sun-Thurs After 9:00pm, and Fri-Sat After 10:00pm

Admission, Tickets, & Ride Specials:

Gate Admission: \$10.00 admission. Children 10 and under are free. Ride tickets are \$1.25 each, \$20.00 for 21 tickets, \$50.00 for 55 tickets and \$100 for 120 tickets. All rides require more than one ticket. Parking is \$5. ATM machines are located throughout the fair.

Online advance discount tickets can be purchased for \$7.00, with children 10 and under free. A book of 21 ride tickets can be purchased for only \$11.00 (a 50% discount) through September 20. Visit our website at www.northgeorgiastatefair.com
